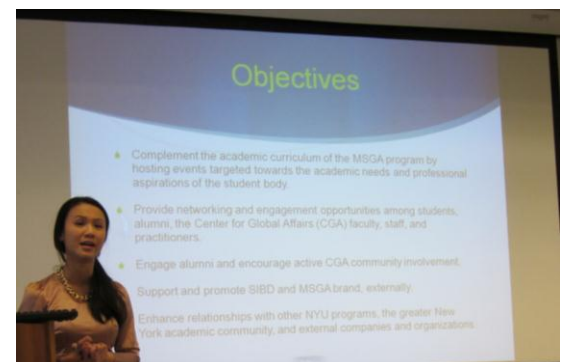
SIBD President, Mary Tran, presented to the membership the accomplishments of the organization since its inception and future objectives of the club, as well as facilitated open, member discussion.
